We will not collect your personal information when you visit our website unless you choose to provide that information to us. We handle information about your visit to our website in the following manner:

Internet Security Policy

For site security purposes and to ensure that this service remains available to all users, this computer system employs software programs to monitor network traffic to identify unauthorized attempts to upload or change information, or otherwise cause damage.

We prioritise the protection and privacy of your data. Microsoft was the first cloud provider recognised by the EUs data protection authorities, for their commitment to EU laws. In addition, the first major cloud provider to adopt the new international cloud privacy standard ISO 27018. Our system does not install and download any files, passwords or system data onto the device you are using and so all information remains secure.

Information Collected and Stored Automatically

If you do nothing during your visit but browse through the website, read pages, or download information, we will gather and store certain information about your visit automatically. This information does not identify you personally. We automatically collect and store only the following information about your visit:

The Internet domain (for example, "xcompany.com" if you use a private Internet access account, or "yourschool.edu" if you connect from a university's domain) and IP address (an IP address is a number that is automatically assigned to your computer whenever you are surfing the Web) from which you access our website the type of browser and operating system used to access our site, the

date and time you access our site, the pages you visit and if you linked to our website from another website, the address of that website.

We use this information to help us make our site more useful to visitors, learn about the number of visitors to our site and the types of technology our visitors use. We do not track or record information about individuals and their visits. We do not store credit / debit card information.

If You Send Us Personal Information

If you choose to provide us with personal information by sending an e-mail to the management or staff, or by filling out a form with your personal information and submitting it through our website, we use that information to respond to your message and to help us provide you with information that you request.

If you choose to provide us with collection and destination address details, make a booking or pay electronically via our website (Payments are processed securely by Worldpay), this information is used in the strictest manner. We will only use this information to deliver a quality service as requested.

All data submitted via our website, company email address or via telephone will be treated as confidential under the Data Protection Act 1998.

Your Personal Information

The information you provide is not given to any private organizations or private persons or third party. We Do Not collect or use this information for commercial marketing. If you submit information through a member of our team this information will be shared only with employees involved in making decisions relative to that information.

How We Protect Personal Data

We know how important it is to protect and manage your personal data. We use computer safeguards such as firewalls and data encryption (SSL) to keep this data safe. We only authorise access to employees who need it to carry out their job responsibilities. Our procedures mean that we may request proof of identity before we share your personal information with you. In the unlikely event that we do suffer a security breach which compromises our protection of your personal information and we need to let you know about it, we will do so.
